Qualifications: Must be a parent and/or primary day-to-day caregiver of a child with serious emotional, behavioral, and/or mental health challenges (SED) who is currently or has in the past, received services from Community Mental Health.
Individuals who are bi-lingual are strongly encouraged to apply.

Impact Family Advocates must possess the following:

- Leadership skills
- Strong oral and written communication skills
- Computer, data entry and email familiarity
- Knowledge of public and private child serving agencies
- Ability to manage time well and work independently
- Ability to take direction
- Respect, value and support of the family and youth voice
- Strong commitment to parent/professional partnerships
- Experience working with diverse populations
- Flexible hours

This position will require flexible hours and occasional weekends, evenings, and overnight travel.

Job Duties: Partner with families to support, educate, and empower them to use their voice, develop positive relationships with service providers, and develop skills to navigate the systems their child and family are involved with. Impact Family Advocates will connect families with community resources, assist them to develop natural supports, and encourage them to engage with service providers. This will be accomplished through team meetings, home visits, and coordination with other agency service providers.
